PROPER

Measures (One measure = 2 steps)

- A1(1-4) Turn a right hand star (must go all the way) I(4)
A1(5-8) 1st corners back-to-back I(2)
(a little tug w/ RHs leads nicely into the back-to-back)
A2(1-4) Turn a left hand star (must go all the way) I(4)
A2(5-8) 2nd corners see-saw (left Shoulder back-to-back) I(2)
(a little tug w/ LHs leads nicely into the see-saw)
- B1(1-2) Partners balance by the RH I(4)
B1(3-4) 1s only: M1 turns W1 under; Ta(2)
MEANWHILE 2s face up
B1(5-6) Neighbors balance by the RH
B1(7-8) Men turn neighbor under H(2+2)
M2 W2
W1 M1
- B2(1-4) 1s half draw poussette w/ lady W1 drawing CW; while
2s half straight poussette CW
B2(5-8) 1s finish w/ half a straight poussette continuing CW; while
2s finish w/ the other half of the straight poussette CW
