<i>Starting position</i>	<i>M1</i>	<i>W1</i>
	<i>M2</i>	<i>W2</i>
	<i>M3</i>	<i>W3</i>

A1(1-4) 1s straight pousette CW to middle;
while M2 leads W2 in a chase CW to the top.

A1(5-8) 1s continue straight poussette CCW to bottom;
while W3 leads chase CCW around to the middle place.
W2 M2
W3 M3
M1 W1

A2 Fountain started by 2s at the top

B1(1-4) All balance partner by the R and turn under
B1(5-8) Middle cu (3s) half fig 8 down thru the 1s at the bottom

B2(1-4) All balance partner by the L and turn under
B2(5-8) Top cu (2s) half fig 8 down thru the middle (3s)

Notes:

The Fountain: The top cu (2s) starts leading down the center of the set.

When the 2s pass the middle (3s), the middle (3s) follows them (2s) leading down the center of the set.

When the 2s pass the 1s at the bottom, the 2s cast around the 1s to dance back up to their (2s) starting position at the top.

When the 3s pass the 1s at the end, they (3s) also cast around back to place.


When the 3s pass the 1s at the bottom, the 1s make a wide cast back to their place.

The *Fountain* is a *neutral* move: everyone ends up where they started.
