The orientation for the diagrams has the music (i.e., the band) at the top of the page.

Starting position M1 W1 M2 W2

Measures:

- A1(1-2) M1 sets once to his corner (W2)
- A1(3-4) 2nd corners (M2 & W1) turn by R hand halfway
- A1(5-8) 1st corners Right shoulder side (aka "Shaw Siding")

M1 M2 W1 W2

- A2(1-2) M2 sets once to his corner (W1)
- A2(3-4) 1st corners (M1 & W2) turn by R hand halfway
- A2(5-8) 2nd corners Right shoulder side

W2 M2 W1 M1

- B1(1-4) All clap 4 times, then cross over by the **Right** and loop R to face in
- B1(5-8) All clap 4 times, then partners turn 2H halfway
- B2(1-4) All lead down a double, turn as a couple and lead up a double to progressed place.
- B2(5-8) 1s continue leading up through 2s (who separate), then cast back to progressed place.

Notes: Have fun in A1(1-2) and A2(1-2). The Lady does not return the set but may acknowledge the Gent in another way of her choosing if she wishes.

At B(4) The 2s stop when they reach their progressed place and separate to allow the 1s to pass through.

>> Claps: It's the Caller's choice how the claps are done.

The Prankster >>>>> Ending measures 25-32 are legato
